

Challenge card

Pick a story card that is different from your own viewpoint. Tell the group how you think your own views are similar and how they are different to the character

Challenge card

Pick a story card. Pretend to be the character on the card and present your views to the group

Challenge card

Imagine what your grandparents would say about this topic. Share your thoughts with the rest of the group.

Challenge card

What do you think of how the media portrays this issue?

Challenge card

Where do you get your information about high blood pressure?

Challenge card

Is the group being polite and not talking about a “taboo” issue in relation to this subject? If so, say “We’re not talking about ...” and start the conversation.

Challenge card

Express any feelings on the subject that you have not yet expressed to the group

Challenge card

Find out what the person on your right hand side feels on this subject. Find an argument to support their opinion.

Challenge card

Find out what the person on your left hand side feels on this subject. Disagree with their viewpoint.

Challenge card

Tell the group who you think pays (in terms of resources, or consequences), and in what ways.

Challenge card

Explain briefly to your group what you think could be the effect on future generations
